This is a NON-REFUNDABLE/NON-TRANSFERABLE deposit!

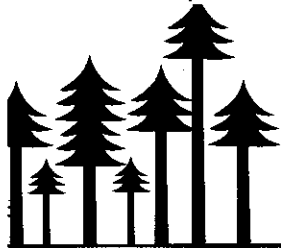
WHAT HAPPENS THROUGHOUT A WAPO WEEK FOR 4-6TH AND 7-9TH GRADERS?

# Frequently Asked Questions



Q. HOW DO I REGISTER MY CHILD FOR CAMP?

A. Please call the youth director at your church. They have all the forms for you and they will want to know about your interest in attending camp. If you want to come individually, we can help you choose an open week. If your church is not on our summer schedule we will need to put your registration on a waiting list until all registrations from churches on our schedule have been processed. It may be good to choose a 1st and 2nd choice week of camp. If there is room in one of your choices, we will accept your registration and send you a verification of your week. If we cannot fit you in, we will call you with some other options.

Q. IF MY CHILD HAS TO CANCEL, CAN I GET A REFUND FOR HIS / HER DEPOSIT?

A. The deposit is NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE. We have this policy to help cover administrative costs.

Q. WHAT IF MY CHILD HAS FOOD ALLERGIES?

A. Please call a week prior to your child's arrival and we will arrange for you to talk to our Food Service Manager. Depending on the severity of the food allergy, we may be able to accommodate your child's stay.

Q. DO YOU HAVE A PLACE TO GO IF THERE IS BAD WEATHER?

A. We have designated safe areas for campers and counselors to go in the event of serious weather conditions.

Q. WHEN IS THE FINAL PAYMENT DUE?

A. Final payment is due 2 weeks prior to arrival. Please contact church youth staff for further information.

Q. WILL MY CHILD BE IN A CABIN WITH HIS / HER FRIEND?

A. Yes! Each camper is asked to list ONE cabin buddy. Each camper will be assigned to a cabin with their listed buddy and with their church group and appropriate age group.

**SPECIAL NOTE:** any article of clothing that we feel may hinder spiritual growth will need to be removed, covered up, or turned inside out. Please do not bring articles of clothing that have alcohol advertisements, cigarette advertisements, crude jokes, or any other sayings or logos that may distract others from growing spiritually. Camp reserves the right to hold inappropriate personal items of campers. Return of the item will, if appropriate, be made at the end of camper's stay. Parental contact and authorization may be necessary for this return.
